Texas is one of the largest states in the country, both in terms of square mileage and population, which should be no surprise considering everything is supposed to be bigger there. That's certainly true as far as the steaks, cowboy hats and football stadiums are concerned, but what about the homes, school systems, salaries and all of the other important factors that truly make life larger in a given place?

Not every city in Texas excels in all of these areas. For instance, Eagle Pass's 14.1% unemployment rate is almost six times higher than Kyle's 2.4% rate, and the median income in University Park (\$215,750) is nearly seven times more than in San Benito (\$32,020). But people prioritize living and working conditions differently, and socioeconomic characteristics vary considerably based on geography. So there figures to be a place for everyone.

In order to help Lone Star residents and those interested in joining the herd settle down in the right spot, WalletHub compared the 112 of the largest cities in Texas based on 21 relevant metrics that speak to their suitability for families of all types. This includes measures such as the number of playgrounds per capita,
